

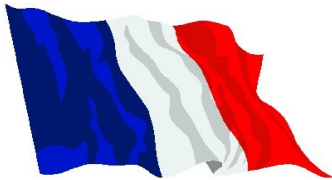
WHEN A FRENCH WINE LOVER MARRIES AN AMERICAN WORD LOVER

Come meet an American writer and her French winemaker husband

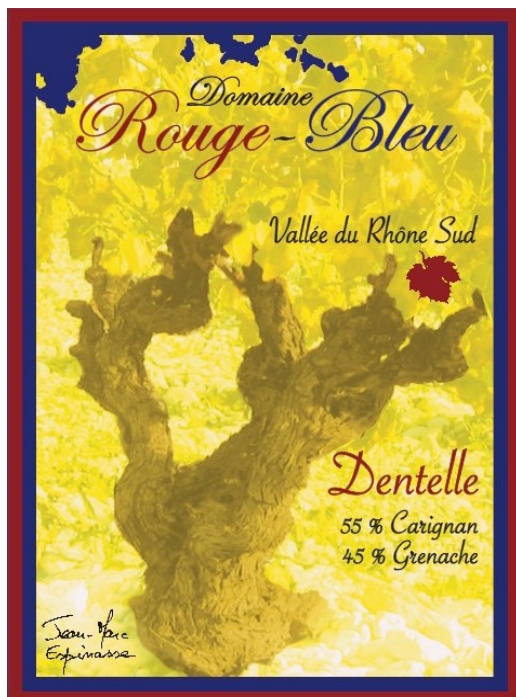

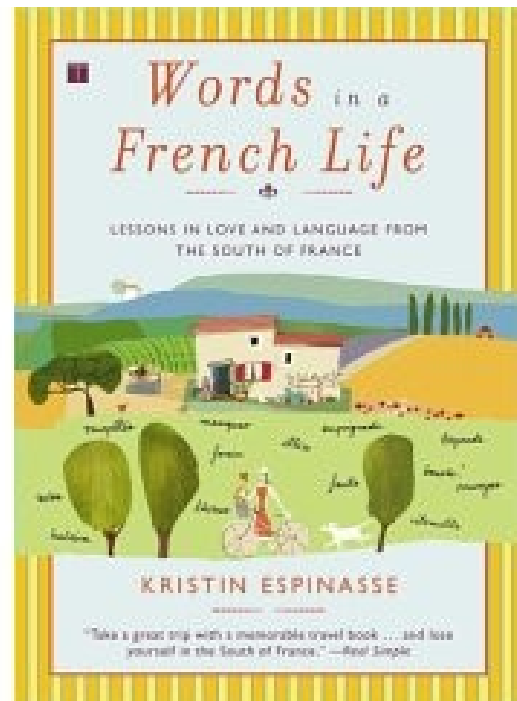
Jean-Marc Espinasse will talk about his love and passion for wine which lead him and his French-American partners to purchase some old vines and create a vineyard, Domaine Rouge-Bleu. He will tell about his wine venture in the Southern Rhône Valley which started 20 years ago when his Uncle bought a few parcels of vines in Châteauneuf du Pape to re-create the family's tradition of making wine. He will pour you his first vintages (Domaine Rouge-Bleu "Dentelle" red and "Mistral" white) which just got rewarded by a Silver medal at the last Paris Concours Général Agricole. A few bottles of his Uncle's Châteauneuf du Pape wine (Domaine du Banneret) will also make it to the wine bar.



Kristin Espinasse will tell her enchanting story of how she became a blogger, a writer and Expat in Provence, while raising two kids and trying to adapt to the French Culture and Language. Her first book, Words in a French Life has been published by Simon and Schuster and she is now writing on the wine venture that the family is experiencing.
